ABSTRACT



The DSDM, Dynamic System Development Method, was developed in the United Kingdom in the mid- 1990. It is a blend of, and extension to, rapid application development and Iterative development practices. Martin Fowler, one of the writers of the Agile Manifesto, believes, "DSDM is notable for matures much of the infrastructure of more traditional methodologies, while following the principles of the agile methods approach". The fundamental idea behind DSDM is to fix time and resources, and then adjust the amount of functionality accordingly rather than fixing the amount of functionality in a product, and then adjusting time and resources to reach that functionality
